Improving Students' English Pronunciation Ability through ...

English is foreign language so they get difficulties to pronounce English words Sometimes their pronunciation and the spelling are different but they guess the words, for example: the word "ball", they will pronounce it /bal/ and they can guess the word by using their logic They usually read the words based on the letters (alphabets)

Pronunciation Problems of Chinese Learners of English

English differ greatly in the number of vow-els While English has 15 vowels (Ohata, 2004), Chinese has only 5 vowels (San, 2007) Because of this difference, Chinese learners need to learn how to pronounce many new vowels when they start to learn English Even when a vowel exists in both Chinese and English, the sound's manner of
