Phonetic Transcription Articulation of Sounds Phonetic Alphabet Transcription International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) About the IPA Contains symbols to represent all sounds from all languages 1-to-1 correspondence between sounds and symbols Includes diacritics to indicate tone, stress, etc Many symbols from or based on Latin and Greek alphabets

IPA The idea: one sound = one symbol a different symbol for each distinctive sound the same symbol should be used for that sound in every language which uses it simple symbols for major sounds (from the roman alphabet where possible) diacritics for more minor modifications Anyone trained in IPA can interpret phonetic transcription,
